I was also lucky to have Bill and Trish Gray as stewards, they are so helpful and efficient, as well as good humoured. Many thanks to them.

There is nothing robotic about Norfolk terriers in the show ring, their temperament shines through. Mouths have definitely improved over the years, with larger teeth and scissor bites. Tails remain very variable. The greatest challenge is movement. That said there are some lovely Norfolks out there displaying super type.

**VD** (2-1) 1 Simpson's **Umbrage Longton Cum Megalex**, a very fit young man of 9 years. He moved with a long stride and held himself well. Good head and well placed ears and dark eye. He has good substance, could be shorter coupled.

PD (5) 1 Stevenson's Brickin Just A Pickle, maturing well for his 10 months, he presented a well balanced outline. Strong head, broad skull, dark eye and good bite. He is well off for bone and substance and short in back, level topline and well set tail that he held well. Good coat in excellent trim. He moved well enough; 2 Smith's Javidel Despicable May, 2 months younger than the 1st and far less mature at the moment. Pleasing head with good expression and yet to develop. Excelled in neck and shoulder, with good layback. Short coupled and well set tail. Confident puppy and showed well. At the present time he is not really driving from behind; 3 McPhee's Kinsridge No Problem, wrongly named, he was more than a challenge for his handler. Such a shame, he oozes quality but decided to be a clown. I hope he settles as he has all the essentials and more; Res Atkinson's Belleville Just Call Me at Manybrook; VHC Walker's Roxypark Spring Time.

JD (6-1) 1 Gee's Watercroft Calling Time, excellent

type as were all the dogs that showed under me from this kennel. Very good head, dark eye and broad skull, good bite, all giving the correct expression. Good shoulder placement, short in back, level topline, well held tail. Well angulated behind. Happy show man, moved well; 2 Jenkins & McCourt's Kinsridge Crackshot, good for type and outline. Pleasing head, neat ears and good expression. Short coupled, level topline, in very good coat and condition. Would prefer more bone. Didn't make the most of himself on the move. Needs time and a willingness to cooperate; 3 Newton's Strathinver Redgold, only just out of puppy, he gave a little away in age and experience. Pleasant head, still maturing and rather long in muzzle. Generally well constructed and good balance. He decided on a circuitous route down the ring, rather than a straight line, which proved difficult for his owner; Res Money's Kinsridge Christmas Cracka; VHC Meldram's Shersal Gold Charm.

PGD (10-1) 1 Montgomery's Lexinor Play The Ace, quality b&t with a very good head and expression, dark eye and neat ears. Well balanced and constructed with good muscle. Very good tail, straight and well held. Steady mover; 2 Hurrion's Villassa Jack Daniels, very good in head and expression with neat ears, well held. Very good coat, well trimmed. Would prefer a little shorter in back and more body. Moved very well; 3 Gee's Watercroft Gold Coin, very attractive dog, in excellent coat and condition. He caught my eye when he came into the ring and I thought he might be my winner in the class. However something happened whilst he was in the ring and he was unable to move soundly; Res Wolleson's Watercroft Pop Idol; VHC Ward's Gordens Boy.

LD (9) 1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Witty Banter, eye catching dog, masculine and most assertive mover of the day. Super head with neat ears, broad skull, strong muzzle and excellent bite. Super coat in excellent trim. Good bone and substance, short back, well muscled hindquarters. Moved with stretch and



drive and carried himself so proudly. He performed better each time he reappeared in the ring. A dog with a future. CC, BOB; 2 Hurrion & Standen's Villassa Jack Be Quick, another free moving dog in excellent condition, with plenty of muscle. Good reach of neck and well placed shoulder. Good tail and tail set. Strong hindquarters. Again he has stretch and drive; 3 Atkinson's Charlie Blake at Moortop, masculine dog with good head and strong body. Very good tail and carriage. Beautiful coat in perfect order and of great texture. Heavier in front than the first 2; Res Hess & Higgins' Umbrage Copacabana; VHC Darnell's Jacquidon Tough As A Nut.

OD (6-1) 1 Stevenson's Brickin Pot Of Pickle, well constructed boy, shown in excellent coat and trim. Broad skull, dark eye and well placed ears. Strong neck into good layback of shoulder. Deep body, short back and well muscled hindquarters. Moved soundly but not quite the sparkle. RCC; 2 Wolleson's Ger/Dk Ch Marshmallows Schoko Drops, such an attractive black and tan with a super coat and colour. Liked his balance and construction, good neck and shoulder and short in back. Excellent head and expression, broad skull, neat ears, strong muzzle and dark eye. Moved well; 3 Horne's Ch Marchdens Mark My Words, well constructed masculine dog carry a little too much weight. Would like a better set tail. He moved and showed well; Res Gullick & Van Stuivenberg's Ch Arderry Penny Red to Jaeva; VHC Van Stuivenberg's Cro Ch Jaeva Bit O'Bover.

**GCD** (1) 1 Brown's **Dajean Dotty's Digger**, impeccably behaved boy, who was so responsive to his handler. Pleasing head and expression, good body and condition. Fluid, strong mover.

VB (2-1) 1 Hurrion's Ch Valentines Cherry Crumble, if all Norfolks could grow older like this one, then the breed would be in excellent shape. 10 years old and moved round the ring with ease. Good head and well constructed, good coat texture and well muscled. BV.

**PB** (9) 1 Darnell's **Jacquidon Rags To Riches**, super cobby puppy with a lot of charm, so typically Norfolk. Broad head, well held ears, strong muzzle. Well balanced with good reach of neck and good body. Well angulated hindquarters, well let down hocks. Moved well. **BP**; 2 Jenkins' **Kinsridge Tip** 

The Wink, all the essentials but finer and less ready than 1. Liked her head and expression, very feminine. Well angulated fore and aft. Moved well; 3 Thompson-Morgan's Villassa Jelligello, strong puppy, Pleasing head and generally well constructed. Plainer in type at the moment; Res Hurrion's Villassa Cherry Stars; VHC Newton's Strathinver Miss Rosemary.

JB (6) 1 Gee's Watercroft Pink Fizz, Such an attractive young lady. Well constructed, with good head and expression and neat ears. Well laid back in shoulder and short coupled. Well muscled and showed this well on the move. Just right for size. Good jacket but still showing signs of puppy coat. She can only improve with age. RCC; 2 Phillips' Blakens Look No Further, beautiful head on this bitch with dark eye and excellent expression. Generally well constructed, with good bone and substance. Not as well balanced 3 Skrobiszewska's You Look At Me Vertragus, she moved well and responded well to her handler, however her head is not her fortune, being long in the muzzle and lacking stop. Also lacks bone; Ward's Rafthouse Bombay Sapphire; VHC Bebb-Evans' Namlak Cinnamon.

PGB (14-7) 1 Gee's Watercroft Top Totty, another from this kennel that is lovely Norfolk type. Broad head, good stop, strong muzzle with excellent expression, neat ears. Muscular neck running into well laid shoulders and short in back. Well angulated hindquarters. Moved well; 2 Devereux's Vichea Indian Summer, very strong girl, with excellent muscle and hard condition. Feels like she could work all day. Variable in enthusiasm when moving; 3 Macartney's Ivrig First Bit Of Joy, pleasing head with broad skull and good expression. Short back and deep chest. Moved happily and soundly. Well schooled; Res Foubister's Kinsridge Gun Chaser; VHC Graves' Nicnips Indulgence.

LB (6) 1. Phillips' Marchdens Look To The Sky for Blakens, caught my eye on entering the ring, just loved her make and shape. Very well balanced, with the right amount of bone and substance. Excellent head, broad in skull, good stop and wide muzzle, dark eye, creating the right expression. Good lay back of shoulder with good reach of neck. Excellent coat and condition, lovely black and tan. She oozes quality. Moved well but felt she was outmoved by the male in the final challenge. BCC; 2 Hurrion's Villassa Country Belle, a very sound girl on the



move, in great condition. Plainer in type than 1 and more workmanlike. However everything in the right place; 3 Atkinsons's **Moortop Clear Choice**, sparkled with enthusiasm throughout the class. Loved her expression and bright eyes. She moved freely and behaved like she had a brain, complying with her handler but at the same time showing personality; Res Gee's **Watercroft Gold Dust**; VHC Darnell's **Jacquidon No Hesitation**.

OB (4) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Ovation, feminine bitch with pretty head and general elegance about her. Perhaps could do with a touch more bone and probably needs to go on maturing. Well ribbed, firm in backline and so well muscled in hindquarters. In excellent jacket and he showed his head off. Just a bit bouncy in front action at present but in profile he shows good ground cover and hock use, BP.

JD (4) 1 Gee's Watercroft Calling Time, I felt the quality of his head and expression edged him the red card. Just enough neck, but he is well ribbed and well boned with good feet. Short in loin and shown in good coat. Side on he covers the ground briskly but toes in a bit when fore viewed; 2 McPhee's Kinsridge No Problem at Foxhouse, so well constructed with big ribs, little loin and so compact in overall shape. He possesses such a good neck which adds to his appeal. Not quite the eye and expression of the winner and he gave his handler a hard time on the move, playing up when coming towards me. But clearly a character; 3 Lloyd's Orison Ice Tee; Res Davies' Lagdenfarm Fidget Pie.

**YD** (1) My stewards were Liz Holmes and her husband of Navarre Miniature poodle fame and post judging Liz said I would be interested in a certain affix and this was it!! Those in a certain age group will recall the fabulous Miniature Poodles of the late great Rita Gee whose Affix was Beritas which is now owned by her niece, hence the Beritas name survives!

1 Walshe's **Beritas The Name's Bond**, very nice type good skull, with lovely eyes but I would like a more weight in muzzle. Beautiful bite and teeth, enough neck, ribs have enough spring, loin a tad long exaggerated by his being between coats. Impressive profile action but another which is a shade wide when fore viewed.

LD (2-1) 1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Witty Banter, another stunning example of the breed from this very clever breeder. I thought him outstanding in today's entry, loved everything about him, gorgeous headpiece, eyes and expression, strong neck, so compact in body spirit level backline, good tail and easily the most accomplished mover of the day. His jacket is so harsh and dense and it finished off a beautiful picture of what a classy Norfolk can look like. Delighted to send him through to the Group and believe I am right in saying that this was his 3rd CC, as I'm told he won his 2nd CC & BOB at Crufts this year. Well done! CC & BOB.

OD (3) 1 Horne's Ch Marchdens Mark My Words, such a typy all male charmer this chap is. So shapely, compact, well ribbed body, lovely weighted bone and good feet. His head is a delight and the expression almost wilfully mischievous from those beautiful eyes. Spotless in presentation he is so very sound and is ultra positive as he circles the ring with that air of bravado. A good class to win, RCC; 2 Stevenson's Ch Brickin Pot of Pickle, unsurprised to read that he is a titleholder. He has that air of being something special, excellent size and proportions, strong neck, so well ribbed, straight fore limbs and well set tail. Shown in full coat and he moves out with a balanced stride. I thought his head handled so well but I just edged the winner to the red card on his slightly more expressive eye; 3 Hurrion & Standen's Villassa Jack Be Quick.

**SBD** (1) 1 Davies' **Lagdenfarm Fidget Pie**, delightful temperament on this very happy fellow. Pleasing head, well defined stop, skull could be a tad wider for a male but he has nice eyes. Well spring ribs, good backline and well muscles. A trifle too wide in front when moving.

**SBB** (5-3) 1 Haydon & Gibbings' **Villassa Jelliwobble** at Earthtaw, such a poppet. Ultra feminine and pretty in expression. Ample neck, level backed, well set tail and a tight, dense fitting coat. A credit in

Thanks to exhibitors for their sporting manners both in and around the ring. Such a friendly show with some super terriers on view. Mouths were nearly all perfect, heads varied with quite a lot rather too narrow with weak muzzles. Necks good, not too long or short, shoulder placements as in a lot of breeds were very varied with a lack of slope to the upper arm, which fore shortens forward reach. Bodies good although "substance" should not mean "fat". Quarters generally first rate, Tails were not as a rule good, with so many laying along the back. As the standard states "not excessively gay" they are hard to deal with as a judge. Perhaps breeders should concentrate more on this point now, as it has been some years since docking was banned. Temperaments were without exception remarkable, with all wanting to kiss me, and say hello. Absolutely delightful to judge such happy dogs.

**SBD** (1) 1 Walker's **Hedgefield Brucey Baby**, good head and eyes, keen expression, quite a good front but turns his feet out a touch. Sound body, slightly cowhocked behind on the move. Excellent coat and very fit and well muscled.

MPD (2) 1 Gee's Watercroft Duty Calls, good looking puppy maybe a touch feminine in head and muzzle. Well made front, short level back. Feet can still tighten up further. Perfect tail carriage, neat and true behind. Promising, BPIS; 2 Harpham & Hulance's Diggery Strikes A Pose, stronger in head, but a little longer in back and slack in topline at present. Feet can still come up a little more with exercise too. Nice baby with a delightful temperament.

**PD** (3-2) 1 Thompson-Morgan's **Belleville Crumble Topping**, strongly made, loved his keen and bright expression. Ears a touch heavy, and he could carry them higher. Sound front, good forechest, excellent bone. Deep enough in chest, firm backline, and OK

in rear. Tail could be carried straighter. He has a rough hard coat too, which was very pleasing for his age.

JD (7-2) 1 Smith's Javidel Despicable May, superb head and correct eye shape and size. Muzzle of good width and length. True front, good bone and feet. Deep enough for age, level back. Fair tail, good quarters. Nice quality; 2 Atkinson's Moortop My Mark Again, a nice hard Terrier all through, not quite as tight at the elbows as above, and a little longer in back. Super head and outlook, and looks a real worker!; 3 Stevenson's Brickin Just A Pickle; Res Gee's Watercroft Brown Sugar; VHC Harpham & Hulance's Diggery Golden Ratio.

**YD** (3-1) 1 Thompson-Morgan's **Belleville Major Key**, smart and dead sound, liked his head and ear set, shoulders set a little far up the neck perhaps. Upper arm slope pretty good though. And he moves with some reach in front. Well bodied and correctly angulated in rear. A good quality dog; 2 Walker's **Roxypark Springtime**, hard coat just coming through. Looked OK standing but was struggling to move on the mats. Flies his ears, lovely eyes and expression. Good topline too.

**PGD** (2) 1 McFee's **Kinsridge No Problem at Foxhouse**, a good honest dog, lovely tail carriage which sets off his outline well. A bit diffident on the table, but came alive on the floor. Good head shape, eyes a wee bit too round, strong muzzle, and deep pigment. Harsh jacket, good front mover, needs a little more rear propulsion; 2 Walker's **Hedgefield Brucey Baby**.

**LD** (5-1) 1 Jenkins & McCourt's **Kinsridge Crackshot**, excellent size and type, Liked his head and skull, good neck and general conformation when I went over him. Rather weak behind but is built

correctly in rear, so I guess he just needs more muscle to improve here; 2 Atkinson's **Charlie Black at Moortop**, slightly bigger dog, hard and very fit. In lovely coat and better behind than winner. He is not so good in front though and swings it coming towards. More length of upper arm would improve; 3 Hess & Higgins' **Umbrage Copacabana**; Res Walshe's **Beritas The Name's Bond**.

**OD** (3) 1 Horne's **Ch Marchdens Mark My Words**, in immaculate condition, and excellent coat. Super to go over and very fit. Liked his head and excellent front construction. Well laid shoulders, and good length to upper arm. Nicely bodied, well ribbed back, level topline and very powerful behind. A good fluid mover in profile too, **RCC**, **RBIS**; 2 Van Stuivenberg's **NL Cro Ch Jaeva Bit O'Bover**, another quality dog but not quite the front of winner and throws his legs up too high in profile movement. Stands well, and I liked his look of "I'm a real male". Super rear, lovely tail set and carriage; 3 Gee's **Ch Watercroft Calling Time**.

**ChD** (Champion Dog)(2-1) 1 Jenkins' **Ch Kinsridge Witty Banter**, good size and proportions of height to length, with enough length of foreleg to give him good clearance. Head OK and expression keen, with well set eyes. Good body under the coat, well angulated in front and rear, and a true and precise mover all ways. Not exaggerated in any way, Exuberant temperament and immaculate presentation, **CC** & **BIS**.

**VD** (2-1) 1 Darnell's **Jacquidon Tough As A Nut**, 7 ½ yr old, in good form. Eyes a little on the round side, otherwise a strong head, and firm muzzle of correct length. OK in front and rear movement, topline dips in profile though. In lovely body condition, and certainly not looking his age, **BV**.

**SBB** (2-1) 1 Macartney's **Ivrig Dancing In The Sun**, really promising puppy, ears rather large, but head shape is good. Excellent neck, shoulders and front. Enough bone for her size, firm backline. Reasonable rear, but she can still muscle up in this area, but she is still young and has plenty of time, **BSBIS**.

MPB (4) 1 Phillips' Blakens Add A Little Sparkle, scrummy baby I really loved, maybe still has to fine down a touch and grow up on the leg a trifle to balance her further. Lovely to go over, and has an enchanting head and expression. Good bone and

feet, Super mover all round. Best Opposite Sex Puppy; 2 Gee's Watercroft On The Q'Tee, a little heavy in ears and not quite the slope of upper arm of winner. Excellent topline, and moved well going away. Tail carried flat to the back unfortunately. Promising coat texture; 3 Brittain's Kinsridge Pretty Penny; Res Jenkins' Kinsridge Top Knot.

**PB** (4-1) 1 Phillips' **Just The One at Blakens**, very nice and so lovely in front and general conformation. Still rather fat and "roly poly" and she does move too wide going away. Lovely head and strong muzzle too; 2 Phillips' **Fairy Tale at Jaeva**, a wee bit longer in back and swinging her front somewhat. Very precise going away, & overall a good puppy, who looks to need time to pull herself together; 3 Macartney's **Ivrig Dancing In The Sun**.

JB (5-1) 1 Harpham & Hulance's Diggery Netflix, difficult decision here. A lovely class. Winner very true and precise moving. Keeping her outline at all times. She has good bone under the coat, smart overall, and good quality; 2 Phillips' Blakens Party Planner, very strongly made and lovely front and upper arm slope. She can still tighten a little more in her front though. Excellent body, topline and quarters. Super tail carriage too; 3 Darnell's Jacquidon Rags To Riches; Res Hess & Higgins' Umbrage Up All Night.

YB (2) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville In The Black, so full of herself, wonderful free and lengthy stride going round. Dead true both ways, and a very good construction under the coat. She has bone, tight feet, and a strong head, neat well carried ears, and a lovely outgoing temperament; 2 Jenkins' Kinsridge Chitchat, more toyish than winner and short steps in profile movement. She is a lovely shape standing and has a super attitude too. Excellent up and down on the go. I just preferred overall strength and bone of winner.

PGB (4-1) 1 Darnell's Jacquidon Nip And Tuck, all three had tails flat to their backs. Winner scored on proportions and good height to length ratio. Sound front, pleasing head and expression. Feet could be thicker. Excellent topline which she keeps beautifully on the move; 2 Macartney's Ivrig First Bit Of Joy, I thought a little more length of neck would improve her although you do not need a long neck in this breed. She too is very sound, deep ribs, carried well back, stands on good legs and feet; Opportunity Start.

Short coupled, neat front, fair head, lovely eyes and expression. Well off for bone too; 2 Gee's Ch Watercroft Gold Dust, has quality but all over the place going away, and stands overangulated in rear too. She does hold her topline well, expertly presented jacket, and she certainly does have ring presence.

Well made body, good in hindquarters which he used well. Nicely balanced outline, in good coat, confident and liked his attitudes; 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville High Spirit, very similar to first but not as finished in head. Liked his overall balance and outline. Good body with a nice spring of ribs, well made hindquarters. In nice coat and condition. Needs to tighten up in front movement, but moves well behind; 3 Newton's Strathinver Time To Star.

**PD** (3-1) 1 Philip's **Nordalset Festivities**, won this class on maturity. Has a good head and expression, good neck and shoulders. Well made body, good outline. Correct tailset, move well both ways, showed well, not in the best of coats; 2 Newton's **Strathinver Time To Star**, gave away lots in age and maturity to first. Needs to fill out in head which I'm sure will come as he grows. Nice body, good outline and correct tailset. Moved nicely with lots of confidence, needs a new coat.
