Note to Veterinary Surgeon

The Kennel Club has moved the Norfolk Terrier into their Breed Health and Conservation Plan under the umbrella of the Kennel Club Dog Health scheme. The Kennel Club's interest in the Norfolk concerns the low overall numbers registered and the possibility of the breed becoming endangered, and the potential impact of health issues on these low numbers. After months of discussion around surveillance options and diagnostics, including Doppler Ultrasound, the future input from the Veterinary Cardiology Society, and the assessment of data from Breed Health Surveys, VetCompass, etc., the Kennel Club has agreed to this plan with the Norfolk Terrier Club of Great Britain.

In the plan we aim to have all breeding dogs and bitches auscultated for cardiac murmurs once yearly, and advise that these dogs and bitches are withdrawn from breeding should a murmur of any kind be diagnosed.
