In good coat and a sound mover, good bone and well balanced, showed well; 2 Howard's **Hatchwoods Flash Gordon**, red in hard coat, lovely well proportioned head, nice size and short coupled, showed and moved well; 3 Owen's **Hoathnor Jackanory**, red in good coat, nice size in good condition for his age, moved & showed confidently.

SPD (2-1) 1 Newton's **Strathinver Red Enough**, smart red with a keen dark eye, and good ears, in good coat and a handy size, showed well.

SJD (3-1) 1 Phillips' Blakens Xpress Yourself, compact red in super coat and well presented, well balanced head with a keen eye, good neck and shoulders, level top line, tail well set on, well balanced throughout, considered him for RCC, must have a bright future; 2 Stevenson's Brickin Fine And Dandy, super headed red with a strong muzzle, dark eyes and good ears, lovely type and in good coat, not quite the movement of the winner on the day.

PGD (10-1) 1 Rayner & Healey's **Settrenda Sirens Sounding**, nice type red with a pleasing head and eye, short coupled and well bodied, in good coat, moved and showed well; 2 Newton's **Strathinver Smart Enough**, typy red that was close up to the winner, lovely shape and size, in good hard coat, pleasing head. A little over excited by the occasion; 3 Simpson's **Umbrage Longton Cum Megalex**, good moving red with dark eyes and well placed ears, in nice coat.

LD (8-3) 1 Ackling's Ruby Rueben, smart com-pact red with a lovely head and expression, good top line, short coupled in good coat and well presented, showed very well; 2 Newton's Penmire Makori at Strathinver, quality red of nice size, dark eyes, level top line, showed well; 3 Mounfield's Arderry Sky Rocket, another quality red with a pleasing head and eye, a lovely type with a good top line and well bent stifles, just short of coat on the day.

OD (7-1) 1 Atkinson's **Moortop No Choice**, dark red with a good head eye and keen expression and neat ears, well balanced and in super coat and well presented, good neck and shoulders, firm top line, well let down hocks, good bone, moved and showed well to take the **CC**; 2 Phillips, Gullick & Wilding's **Ch Jaeva Made In Gold**, another quality red with a super head, eye, and ears, well presented in good coat, good reach of neck and level top line, showed well. **RCC**; 3 Smith's **Javidel May Just Have Too**, smart red dog that is a lovely type, but short of coat on the day.

GCD (2) 1 Owen's **Hoathnor Jackanory**; 2 Child & Johnson's **Nordalset Another Look**, b&t with a great temperament, dark eyes good ears, nice size, not moving well today.

VB (5-2) 1Atkinson's **Ch Hobsons Choice at Moortop**, red of quality, the oldest in the class and still looking good, a lovely type with a good head and nicely balanced body, well put down and moving and showing well; 2 Ruffles'

Ruffnor Secret Wish, red in short hard coat, pleasing head and eye, firm level topline, well bent stifles, moved and showed nicely; 3 Philips' **Nordalset Winter Woolies**, red with a super head and dark eyes, very good dentition for her age, shown in full coat and very much enjoying her day out.

SPB (7-1) 1 Gee's Watercroft Top Of The Pops headed this class of promising young bitches just shading out her kennel mate. This bitch has a lovely well balanced head for her age, nicely balanced body, good top line, well boned, with good hind angulation, moved with style and showed well. BP; 2 Gee's Watercroft Top Tia very much the same applies as the winner, but not quite as ready on the day; 3 Phillips' Blakens Party Girl, b&t of good type with a lovely head and eye, very good in profile and in good coat and well presented, showed well.

SJB (7-2) 1 Jenkins' **Kinsridge Kerfuffle**, typy red with a lovely head, eye, and expression, in good coat, short coupled and well bodied, moved and showed well; 2 Hurrion's **Villassa Cherry Ripple**, well presented red with a pleasing head eye and expression, good ears, level top line, a lot to like about this bitch but her movement let her down on the day; 3 Craddock & Collins' **Fontanesi Golden Twist**, close up to the first two, red of good type with a lovely head and eye, a nice size, in good coat, moved and showed well.

PGB (8-1) 1 Jenkins' **Kimmax Kushy Number at Kinsridge**, well balanced red with a lovely head eye and expression, well bodied short coupled, in good coat, moved with purpose and showed well. 2 New's **Raven Beauty**, b&t that was close up to the winner, in good coat and well presented, showed well; 3 Saltmarsh's **Pipridges Hazel**, red with a confident air about her, keen eye, in good coat, a nice mover that showed well.

LB (9-2) 1 Devereux's **Vichea Easter Lily**, quality red with a good head and eye, short coupled, well developed chest, well set tail, in good coat moved and showed well; 2 Broom & Davies' **Roxway Final Chapter**, when this bitch came in to the ring I thought she was my winner. Dark red in the best coat of the day, this bitch is so well balanced with a superb outline, lovely reach of neck well angulated shoulders, level top line and the best of tails. Well handled and presented. Lack of head furnishings held her back on the day, spoiling her expression; 3 Gee's **Watercroft Wedding Belle** another nice red with a good head, well balanced body, moved and showed well.

OB (6) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Honey Nut Crunch, lovely type red, a nice size with a well-balanced head and dark keen eyes, good reach of neck, level top line well let down hocks, in good coat and well put down, a nice mover that showed well. BCC & BOB. 2 Jenkins Ch Kinsridge Top Score, lovely headed red of quality, well balanced and a nice size for a bitch, in good coat and well presented. Unfortunately she was a little distracted in her class, but pulled out all the stops in the challenge to take the RCC. 3 Coopers' Ch Settrenda Saucy Sox, red that I have often admired from the ring side, a lovely type that always shows well, I thought she was looking a little matronly



on the day.

GCB (3-1) 1 Ruffles' Ruffnor Secret Wish; 2 Ruffles' Ruffnor Off Beat, good type red with dark eyes and good ears, firm top line well bent stifles, showed nicely.

MPD (4-1) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Roll Call, a smart looking puppy, good outline, clean head and expression, nice eye, correct bite, well placed ears, clean front, tight feet, good reach of neck running down to well placed shoulders. Nice topline, tail on top, good angulation, moved well both ways; 2 Jenkins' Kinsridge Cash Back, a nice type with good attributes, nice head and ears, good expression, straight front, good neck and topline, strong quarters. A little unsettled on the move can only improve; 3 Hitchin's Kreatin Telling Tales.

PD (2) 1 Jenkin's Kinsridge Quids In, a smart puppy with attitude, pleasing head and expression. Well placed ears, nice straight front and well boned, tight feet, good reach of neck, well laid shoulders. Good topline when standing and moving, good angulation, moved well both ends, good presentation. RBD and BPIS; 2 Newton's Strathinver Red Enough, good head, dark eye, good neck and topline, strong quarters, moved fair behind, front and feet not his fortune.

JD (1) 1 Phillips' **Blakens Xpress Yourself**, a quality dog with great presence. Nice size, good head and ears, correct bite, nice clean straight front and well boned tight feet, good reach of neck, short back, level topline, tail on top, well angulated quarters, moved well going away and coming to. **BD** and **BIS**.

ND (1) 1 Newton's **Strathinver Red Enough**

PGD (1) 1 Darnells' **Jacquidon Tough As A Nut**, a sound up to size dog, good head and expression, nice topline, tail on top, good angulation, good substance all round, moved ok, presented well.

LD (2) 1 Steveson's **Brickin Fine And Dandy**, good type, good head and ears, good bite, straight front, good feet, nice topline and tailset, well angulated quarters, good coat and presentation; 2 Mounfield's **Arderry Sky Rocket**, nice head and expression, good reach of neck but a tad long in back, moved OK, needs a new coat.

OD (4) 1 Phillips, Gullick & Wilding's Ch Jaeva Made In Gold, nice head and expression, good reach of neck, well laid shoulder, short back, tail on top, well angulated quarters, moved ok front and back; 2 Smith's Javidel May Just Have Too, nice head, dark eye, good bite, a little wide in front, short back, good quarters, moved OK behind but weaved in front; 3 Atkinson's Moortop No Choice.

MPB (5) 1 Phillips' Blakens Sugar Candy Kisses, very much a baby but quality is there. Nice head with a feminine expression. Nice neck and shoulders, short coupled, moved well for age, a nice package; 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Just Magic, nice outline, nice head and expression, good neck and topline, tall on top good coat and colour, moved

well behind, needs to tighten in front; 3 Atkinson's **Moortop Another No Choice**.

PB (5) 1 Smith's **Javidel Definitely Maybe**, b&t, a nice type girl, good coat and colour, good expression, nice neck and shoulder, good topline, good quarters, moved and showed well. **BPB**; 2 Phillips' **Blakens Party Girl**, similar in type to winner, happy disposition, pleasing expression, nice kind eye, well placed ears, short back, quarters well angulated, good coat and colour, moved OK; 3 Gee's **Watercroft In The Mix**.

JB (5-1) 1 Gee's Watercroft Top Of The Pops, good outline, good head and expression, good front, nice topline and tailset, good mover, good coat and colour, well presented. RBB; 2 Stevenson's Brickin Upper Crust, a typy bitch well put together, nice in head, good legs and feet, plenty of bone, nice reach, good topline tai on top, moved OK, needs a little training; 3 Craddock & Collins' Fontanesi Golden Twist.

NB (1) 1 Gee's **Watercroft Oh My Darling**, a very tidy type, nice head and expression. Good topline and tailset, strong quarters. Moved well in front, little close behind.

PGB (1) 1 Gee's **Watercroft Top Tia**, another sound type from this stable, good in head, nice front, good reach of neck running into well laid shoulders. Tailset and topline OK, moved OK both ends, well presented, lacks a little confidence.

OB (3-1) 1 Thompson-Morgan's **Belleville Silk Slippers**, a quality bitch well put together, nice reach of neck, good topline and tailset, neat front and feet, moved well both ways, would like a bit more head for the full picture. **BB**; 2 Devereux's **Vichea Easter Lily**, nice head, ears, expression, good topline, good coat and colour, moved OK in front, needs to strengthen behind.

MPD (3) 1 Hitchin's Kreatin Tellin Tales, b/t. Liked him a lot for his overall type, size and shape. Good bite with dark eye of correct shape. Skull developing well, good neck into well laid shoulders & a straight front. Good length of ribs & a decent hind action. Enough bone. Moved & showed well. BP; 2 List's Nicnips Dirty Harry, red dog of good size, make, shape. Coud forgive his coat texture as novice handler who was new to the breed and could have been prepared to be exhibited in better coat; 3 Cooper & Simpson's Settrenda Secret Squirrel.

PD (2) 1 Newton's **Strathinver Red Enough**, red dog of good type & size. Good head proportions, dark eye & good bite. Good neck, could be better in front but balanced with his hind action presented well; 2 List's **Nicnips Dirty Harry.**

JD (1) 1 Stevenson's **Brickin Fine And Dandy**, liked him for his head & expression. Good strength of muzzle & bite. Upto size with a good topline with tail set on & carried well. Could be a little stronger behind & move with a more purpose.

ND (1) 1 Newton's **Strathinver Red Enough**. **PGD** (0)

LD (2) 1 Ackling's Ruby Rueben, a dog whom I have admired before from ringside. Not the biggest but balanced & all in proportion. Correct head & skull with dark eye & good bite. Good length of neck with well laid shoulder & straight front, short backed with a level topline. Coat of good texture & presented well. Was disappointed with how this lad didn't move with the purpose & drive that I know he can however I must judge dogs on the day; 2 Mounfield's Arderry Sky Rocket, different in type to 1 being overall larger & rangier. Strong head & lovely expression with dark eye & good bite. Not as short backed as 1 but in proportion, well off for bone. Coat coming in well. Moved, handled & presented well.

OD (6) 1 Mitchells's **Roxway Direct Line**, I have previously awarded this dog RCC last time I judged & he has got better with age! Needs to be gone over to appreciate him. A dog who possesses characteristics the standard asks for, not in anyway glamorous but a functional honest dog. Excellent bite with large teeth, well rounded skull, enough stop. Overall balanced standing & on the move. & showed well; 2 Devereux's **Vichea Geisha Girl**, very feminine bitch, not the finish of 1 at this age. Liked her head expression. Would prefer a slightly darker eye. Will tighten in front in time. Short behind with low driving hocks. Will present a pretty picture in months to come.

There are some good tails in the breed now, well set and held fairly straight. Temperaments were excellent on the day.

MPD (4) 1 Phillips' Jaeva Go For Broke, well balanced puppy, happy and outgoing. Well put together, short back and good tail. Moved well though still a little loose in front, however plenty of time ahead for this to improve; 2 Phillips' Blakens Sugar Candy Dips, attractive puppy in good coat and moving out well. Today I felt he lacked the reach of neck of 1 and not so well placed in shoulder. However there is still growing time; 3 Gee's Watercroft In A Pickle, another well balanced puppy with good head and soundly made. Lost out today because he was reluctant on the move. I felt the handler needs to slacken the lead as he resented so much control.

There was a very good entry of 57 dogs for the club's 15-class held at the Village Hall, Weedon. The last time I was at this venue was to say a final goodbye to Elisabeth Matell – it is so hard to believe that a whole year has passed since her untimely death. In many ways I still find it unbelievable that she is no more & I cannot look at a Norfolk without thinking of Elisabeth. All the way through my judging today I kept thinking of little comments she may be making at ringside. I hope she approved of the results! The breed misses her, I am sure, I know I do every day.

Back to the present. I was delighted to find a great improvement in quality, especially in the dogs. The day started with a marvellous MPD class where the three placings could have been switched in any order as they were three lovely puppies.

Mouths do need watching as I had several wth crowded mouths, small teeth & level bites. There were also a few with big ears — not medium. Hind movement was better than I remember from before but a number lacked reach in front action. Coats & presentation were excellent on the whole — this breed is lucky to have some really first class handlers & presenters in their midst. There were a few shown in soft condition & on the plump side & also some that should have had their coats tidied up & nails cut to compete at a ch show.

It was a very good show with a warm & friendly atmosphere. Tinged with sadness, of course, but I was able to enjoy my day with the Norfolks very much. Well organized with a tasty lunch & Edward Allen kept me in order stewarding most efficiently.

MPD (4-1) Super class full of promise & potential. 1 Gee's Watercroft In A Pickle, 8½ months, lovely head & expression, excellent bone & body, harsh jacket, strong quarters, needs to firm up in front movementbut that is being picky. Positive showman who moved well behind. Well proportioned. By BIS winner. BP; 2 Atkinson's Blakens Sugar Candy Dips, 7½ months, lovely coat, plenty of body. Good bone & feet, compact & shapely, low set hocks, well carried tail, already a good little mover, showed steadily. Not the head or expression of 1; 3 Phillips' Jaeva Go For Broke.

PD (2) 1 Gee's Watercroft Diamond Dealer, 11½ months red, pleasing head, expressive eyes, excellent ribcage, compact body, well coated & presented, showed well but could have a little more reach in front movement; 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Take Note, 11 months but quite immature looking compared to 1 & coat not at its best. Keen expression, ears on the large side, panting all the time. Short back, moved OK, showed well using his neck when something took his interest. I found one or two non scissor bites, some small teeth but worryingly a number with quite fine muzzles. On a cheerier note, I was thrilled to watch the BOB winner give a sterling performance in the big ring & go on to G4 in a very, very strong group. It augurs well for the future of this youngster of 14 months who was winning his first CC.

MPD (6-1) 1 Atkinson's Blakens Sugar Kandy Dips, what a start to the day with this absolute charmer. All of a piece, lovely size, so compact, big ribbed, beautiful head, eyes & that game for anything expression. He is so well ribbed, excellent backline & holds himself so arrogantly on the move. Great presentation & I am sure he will go on to be a force in the breed next year; 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Stocking Up, just 8 months this little livewire is a real handful as he is so full of his own importance. I see he is a half brother to the BOB. Full of Norfolk charm, excels in neck, backline, strong bone & such a good bend of stifle. His head is a delight & once he learns a little discipline on the move, his future will be assured; 3 Riley's Millstrand Cut The Mustard.

PD (2) 1 Riley's Millstrand Cut The Mustard, this well bodied & ribbed b/t is unlucky in that he is short of neck which detracts from his overall appeal in stance. Head handles well, really good ring, bags of substance & he holds his backline so firmly as he motors around the ring. His head is well balanced, good muzzle & such dark eyes. Well presented; 2 Stevenson's Brickin Countrywide, smaller all through & not quite the weight of bone of the first & he needs to develop in body to gain width behind the withers. He does have a lovely neck & head carriage & he has really good hind angulation. Played hs handler up on the move, especially when coming towards me. JD (6-1) 1 Phillips, Gullick & Tate's Jaeva Cufflink, I hope he doesn't grow on as he is big enough already but he is impressive to handle. All male in outlook, strong head, beautiful eyes & ears, powerful neck, well laid shoulders & firm in body. So compact with good bone & he was in spotless coat condition. Moved out with reach & drive & never let up showing. I shall watch his career with interest; 2 Phillip's Blakens The Kandy Man, he almost snatched the red card as he is so me in head, gorgeous eyes & that expression is a delight. Such a compact chap, enough neck, good layback in shoulder, well bodied & a good backline with a nice bend of stifle. He was amply alive when in stance but just did not put all in on the move, lacking the oomph & purpose of Cufflink. Could finish really well; 3 Gee's Watercroft Diamond Dealer.

PGD (2-1) 1 Sant's **Nordalset Look To The Future**, pleasing headpiece, good eye shape & colour beautiful set of gnashers, enough neck which is powerful, lovely spring to his ribcage which has depth & he is well muscled in hindquarters. Not in full coat but what he had was groomed to perfection. Holds himself well on the move.

LD (3) 1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Cash Back, heaps to like, correct size & substance, certainly compact with a good body, level back, excellent coat & presentation & he has a delightful headpiece with especially good eyes & expression. He is sound in action but in the challenge he could not match the verve & drive of the CC winner. I believe he is sitting on 2 CCs & hopefully the third will come along, RCC; 2 Darnell's Jacquidon Tough As A Nut, a size larger & heavier all through & while his head is balanced & good to handle, I feel his eye is just on the full side so his expression is less appealing than Cash. Lovely ribbing, stunning coat & he moved out with a spring in his step; 3 Ackling's Ruby Rueben.

OD (6-1) 1 Thompson-Morgan's **Belleville Seduction**, just 14 months but this b/t just sold himself to me the longer he was in the ring. Attitude to burn, stunning head, eyes, ears & expression, lovely strength in muzzle & that compact, sturdy body shape with a level back & a good tail. Flawless in coat condition & once his enthusiasm was curbed, he displayed a wonderfully powerful action, really using his hocks to produce a seemingly effortless gliding action. I wish him well. CC, BOB & G4; 2 Green's Wharfvalley Diamond Star, another lovely example of the breed, this red dog has a quality headpiece, lovely foreface, beautiful eyes & that bright, anticipatory expression. He is well boned, has excellent feet & was in good coat. Sound as a pound but not the rear propulsion of Seduction as they circled the ring. Nonetheless a dog of much charm; 3 Phillips, Craddock & Collins' Ch Fontanesi Golden Chalice with Jaeva.

VD (2) 1 Riley's **Lastarean Check Mate at Millstrand**, scores in head properties with really good eyes giving a typical expression, back firm & level, in stunning condition & fairly lively in action; 2 Philip's **Hey Smart Lookin at Nordalset**, red dog, so sound moving, the tightest of feet & well boned. Topline sagging a trifle, well balanced head but his eyes are a tad full for me. In good bloom.

MPB (6-1) 1 Hurrions Villassa Star Turn, I found her most appealing in expression, utterly feminine in outlook yet so alive & ready for anything. Loved her size & well weight bone, she is nicely ribbed, sufficient neck, firm backline & she holds herself so well on the move. Her head I liked a lot, so balanced, slightly rounded in skull, ample stop & those eyes; 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Call Of The Wild, I see is another half sister of the BOB & I know this one was attending her first show & she was full of herself! Understandably a bit



of a fidget but when she settled the shape is a delight. Compact, good neck, stunning head balance, neat ears & such dark eyes which dare you not to like her. Did everything you could want for a first show & once she settles to the job in hand on the move, she will do really well; 3 Stevenson's **Brickin Surprise Surprise**.

PB (5-2) 1 Phillips' **Jaeva Play The Ace**, breed type in spades! Style, shape, soundness, showmanship, stunning head & expression, spotless jacket, fleet footed & holds herself so well as she circles the ring. What more could you ask for? I believe she is aptly named & she certainly was a joy to judge. **CC & BP**; 2 List's **Nicnips Evensong**, nicelty headed, eye could be a little less full for me, so well ribbed & bodied, shade long in loin, excellent coat condition & her smooth, balanced profile action earned her this placing; 3 Broom's **Roxway Fable**.

JB (8-3) 1 Phillips' Blakens Sugar Candy Kisses, I see this gorgeous youngster is the third member of the same litter which won under me today. She is so very compact, well ribbed, excellent bend of stifle, strong in hock, back as steady as a rock & she was in excellent coat. I loved her head & expression, stunning eyes & neat ears, To me she just screams breed type & hopefully she will go on to better things. The sheer attitude & drive of the BCC winner on the move settled the score; 2 Davies' Perrisblu Playtime, lots to like in this very smart bitch. Good head, dark eyes giving a lovely expression, ample neck, well ribbed, a shade longer in loin than the winner but her backline is level. She is well boned with very good feet & she can motor as she circles the ring;

3 Green's Wharfvalley Wild Child.

PGB (6) 1 Atkinson's Moortop Again No Choice, what a free striding, sound actioned bitch this is. I liked her head pattern, the expression enhanced by such lovely dark, oval eyes & the neatest of ears. She scores in foreface, lovely mouth & a good head carriage. Her ribs have depth, she is short in loin, so compact & shapley with really good hindquarters; 2 Belleville Call of The Wild; 3 Hess & Higgins' Umbrage The Gloriana.

Her head is charming, such a good eye & expression & her muzzle is lovely. Moved out well; 2 Saltmarsh's **Pipridges Hazel**, unfortunately this red is between coats which did not help her cause. Very good head shape, lovely strength in muzzle, such a good mouth & well ribbed. A bit lethargic on the move; 3 Darnell's **Watercroft Cherry On Top**.

OB (4) 1 Hurrion's Ch Villassa Cherry Ripple, has a definite air of quality & am unsurprised to see she is already titled. I loved her expression, the head is so balanced, neat ears & lovely eyes. She is compact, well made with decent angles both ends, her backline is firm & she was in good bloom. Sound in profile action & she showed her head off; 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Just Magic, this teenager is just a bagful of beans & personality plus. Not nearly so finished as the winner yet, but she has style, is compact, well weighted bone & is quite something else in action. Just needs to mature & then she will become a threat to many; 3 Gee's Watercroft Top Of The Pops.

VB (2-1) 1 Hess & Higgins' **Kapitada Fireopal at Umbrage**, 9 years young, in spotless coat, fit as the proverbial flea & showed many of the youngsters just how well the breed can move. Pleasing head, expression so alive, excellent muscletone & never stopped trying.
